

AJO FOREVER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP of The Erie Community Foundation

This scholarship was established in 2013 by **Alyssa Josephine O'Neill's** family and friends in loving memory of a truly wonderful young woman. O'Neill, an 18-year old Penn State Behrend nursing student, asked her parents to take her to Starbucks for a pumpkin spice latte. They didn't get a chance as Alyssa, who had epilepsy, died Sept. 4 after suffering a grand mal seizure. Her family wanted to honor her memory so they decided to pay it forward and let some other people enjoy what Alyssa didn't get a chance to have; hoping they'll spread the kindness and do a nice thing in honor of our daughter." The family paid for the next 40 pumpkin spice lattes for the next 40 customers at Starbucks and asked that a purple sharpie be used to write #AJO on each cup. Starbucks employees were so touched by the gesture that they donated the free drinks they earn each shift - 93 pumpkin spice lattes in all. Supporters started similar pay-it-forward gestures where pumpkin-flavored drinks and treats are sold.

A Facebook page was created and within five days had more than 8,000 likes, an unusually high amount for a local tribute page. Acts of goodwill with the #AJO hashtag were pouring in for the family on Facebook, Twitter and Instagram from all over the world. Ultimately this wealth of generosity has resulted in a heartwarming number of monetary donations that Alyssa's family has used to establish this scholarship in her honor.

Alyssa was a McDowell High School cheerleader and an ambassador for Epilepsy awareness.

Amount: to be determined annually

Eligibility:

- Must be a graduating senior from an Erie County, PA high school
- A 3.0 GPA or higher is required
- Must be pursuing a nursing degree

Criteria:

- Preference will be given to those who are employed and have participated in high school, community, and church activities
- This is an academic scholarship based on merit as evidenced by high school transcripts and standard aptitude test scores
