The women of Erie Women's Fund are amazing. In 2007, twelve altruistic women sought to use their collective philanthropic efforts to change our community, empowering women and families through local nonprofits. The influence of these women set the Erie Women's Fund on a clearly defined path to positively impact our community, change lives generationally.

As you know, we had another busy year making a difference to others. Our annual major grant of \$100,000 was awarded The Mercy Center for Women for their Women Empowered Achieve results "WEAR" program. This grant helps MCW offer GED & job readiness classes to women at their center and through the Erie Community College as well as learning opportunities for kids through the expErience Children's Museum. The Furchak-Ferko Grant cycle began with up to \$25,000 being awarded and the winner announced at EWF Holiday party. With the awarding of the Furchak-Ferko Grant, the EWF will surpass the \$1,000,000 milestone for dollars donated to the Erie community, empowering women, and families.

Our education sessions provided great learning opportunities for our membership. Dr. Kelly Hayes from UPMC presented "Taking the Lead on your Heart Health." Our Women in Leadership Series: Industrial Leaders included a panel discussion with Elisabeth Smith, President Acutec Precision Aerospace, Inc., and Ashleigh Walters, President of Onex, Inc. Thank you to Stephanie Williams, chair of the education committee, and team for providing a link between EWF members and our community.

I appreciate the EWF Steering Committee for their compassion, energy, vision, and talent for making things happen. Grants Committee 2022

The Grants Committee has been hard at work this year! Our 2022 Major Grant of \$100,000 was awarded at the summer gathering in July. This year, the award went to the Mercy Center for Women for their Women Empowered Achieve Results (W.E.A.R) Program. This program will offer GED and job readiness classes to women at the center through the Community College while their children are learning through the expERIEnce Children's Museum. This program is aimed at helping women achieve family-sustaining wages. The Mercy Center was selected from over 30 local nonprofits who submitted their applications. After the grants committee narrowed down the applications, the final vote went to each of our members to make this decision.

Then on September 15th, the Furchak-Ferko grant cycle began. This grant cycle has been made possible by a forward-thinking philanthropist, Mary Furchak, who left a legacy gift in the interest of Women and Families in Erie. This year, we have decided to award up to \$25,000 to deserving nonprofits. We received well over 30 applications, a testament to the need of this program. Upon review of the grants committee, we have decided to award the following grants:

\$20,000 to the Sisters of St. Joseph Neighborhood Network to provide 10, \$2,000 grants for home repairs on female-led homes.

\$5,000 to Operation Warm to provide over 250 coats and boots to local students.

Upon awarding these grants, the Erie Women's Fund surpasses a very notable milestone... **The Erie Women's Fund has officially granted over \$1,000,000 since the inception of the fund!** This is quite an achievement for what started as a small group of women with a big idea and a passion for philanthropic endeavors. Thank you to all of you for making this possible, and for your continued support to cross more milestones.

For the upcoming year, our longtime co-chair, Emily Cox will be stepping down from her position to make room for a new vice-chair. Linda Corso has been a part of the Erie Women's Fund since relocating back to Erie in 2021. We are excited to have her in a leadership role this year and extend a huge thank you to Emily for her time dedicated to the Fund.
