Historically, the LGBTQ+ community has faced barriers to accessing quality healthcare due to discrimination, stigma, and lack of knowledgeable and welcoming providers. Additionally, many LGBTQ+ people face challenges that increase health risks and can lead to negative health outcomes. Combined, this creates health disparities for LGBTQ+ individuals compared to their cisgender, heterosexual counterparts. This is a concern across communities, including here in Erie.

LGBTQ+ affirming healthcare is a critical component of ensuring that all individuals have access to high-quality healthcare services, regardless of their sexual orientation or gender identity. It is important for healthcare and social service providers to understand the unique health needs and experiences of LGBTQ+ individuals, and for facilities to provide a welcoming, inclusive, and competent environment.

Our panel will discuss the current healthcare landscape for LGBTQ+ individuals in our area, and what resources are available.
